



ProfMasters Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy

The Professional Masters in Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy is a four-year clinical programme that contributes to the education and training of psychoanalytic psychotherapists. Our Professional Masters in Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy is recognised by APPI, a body within the Psychoanalytic Section of Irish Council for Psychotherapy (ICP).

Course Overview

The programme's content develops understanding of and engagement with the principles underlying the clinical practice of psychoanalysis, a discipline launched by the pioneering work of Sigmund Freud. The programme content is also strongly informed by the work of French Psychoanalyst and Psychiatrist, Jacques Lacan, whose seminars have been translated into English by the founder of the Masters programme, Dr. Cormac Gallagher (www.lacaninireland.com).

Open to:

This Professional Masters programme is crucially relevant for any mental health professional, including GPs, psychiatrists, psychologists, social workers, social care workers, therapists, chaplains, counsellors, and nurses. The programme also accepts applications from candidates from other backgrounds who have been engaged in their own psychoanalysis.

Eligibility

As a basic requirement for engaging with the psychoanalytic field all students are expected to be engaged in their own personal psychoanalysis before starting the programme, for its duration and beyond. It is required that students can put in place arrangements to work with patients psychoanalytically. This can be discussed at interview.
