Top legal faculty

Throughout this programme students will be stimulated with discussions and analysis from top legal faculty, who have engaged in major research spanning the full range of international commercial law; from the World Trade Organisation through competition law in the domestic, European and international contexts, to the issues arising out of international commercial arbitration.

Course Content and Structure

$$\begin{array}{c} \boxed{90 \text{ credits}} \\ \text{masters} \end{array} = \begin{array}{c} \boxed{60 \text{ credits}} \\ \text{taught modules} \end{array} + \begin{array}{c} \boxed{30 \text{ credits}} \\ \text{dissertation} \end{array}$$

Applicants may choose to commence their study in September or January. Students study three modules each semester. Students choose a minimum of three of the following modules:

- Corporate Governance
- EU Competition Law
- International Commercial Arbitration
- Law of International Finance
- Regulatory Governance
- Patent Law
- International Tax Law

The option to study abroad for semester 2 in one of our sister law schools in locations across Europe is available on a competitive basis.

Entry Requirements

- This programme is intended for applicants with a Law degree, or an interdisciplinary degree in which law was a major component. An upper second class honours, or international equivalent is required.
- Applicants holding a Graduate Diploma in Law may be considered.
- Exemption may be given to those with significant, relevant, practical experience or those with a relevant graduate qualification.
- Applicants whose first language is not English must also demonstrate English language proficiency of IELTS 6.5 (no band less than 6.0 and 6.5 or above in reading and writing), or equivalent.
