<p>Communicating research findings in Citizen Science projects is important - and ArcGIS StoryMaps is one of the tools which can be used to do this. This training session organised by is open to UCD researchers, academics, staff, PhDs with an interest in mapping. You can book your place on this training session further below.</p>

<p>In this three-hour hands-on workshop (with coffee break included!), step-by-step guidance will show you how to create an online story using ArcGIS StoryMaps.</p>

<p>ArcGIS StoryMaps is a product from Esri, and is designed for sharing research findings, historical narratives, and place-based stories online. It enables users to create web-based map narratives that incorporate geographic data, text, and images to make engaging and interactive multimedia stories.</p>

<p>This workshop will be run by <strong>Laura Kearney</strong>, Research Scientist with the <strong><a href="https://waterlands.eu/">WaterLANDS</a></strong> project, UCD School of Architecture, Planning & Environmental Policy, and offer an introduction to the fundamental features of ArcGIS StoryMaps. By the end of the session, you will have created a StoryMap on a cultural landscape using files and data provided.</p>

<p>This is an introductory workshop <u>which will be held in-person</u> and is designed for those with little or no mapping experience.</p>

<p>Whether you're sharing research or simply aiming to inform and inspire through maps ArcGIS StoryMaps provides a user-friendly platform to create engaging



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stories with maps, enhancing your ability to convey information effectively. You can use ArcGIS StoryMaps for a wide range of topics, whether they are in the sciences or humanities.
